I have lived in Hong Kong for over 17 years and have worked for an Italian Eyewear Company as an Office Manager since 1996. I am a Born Again Christian of Italian descent.

I met Elijah sometimes in 1990 and our friendship started developing. He immediately struck me as an original person and very outgoing. While in the process of changing jobs and having decided to move out from the present employer's accommodation, I rented a room in a house he was living in together with another friend. We developed a nice friendship that later turned into love and we agreed we were Married. We Sealed our marriage in a church in Hawaii on April 15th 1993 after deciding to start a family, and God later blessed us with a wonderful daughter, Sarah-Marie. Meanwhile Elijah formed a joint-venture with two other shareholders and I was helping with the business. Later on, one of the shareholders offered me a Marketing Manager position in his company and I worked for him till 1996. During late 1995, our first son, Shiloh, was born. The present job was also a result of a friendship that Elijah had developed with a then G.M. of an eyewear components company. Our youngest son, a result of much prayer, was born in 2002 while I was already working in this present job.

Elijah is a highly gifted person and he loves the Lord more than anything else. He introduced me to Jesus before our marriage in Hawaii and I was Baptized and Saved as a result. He also has an unconditional love for others and for all things that are righteous. He always stands by his beliefs and never vacillates. You could compare him to a modern apostle with an outgoing personality topped with an unconditional and openly professed faith. I have never met any other Christian who would speak so openly of the Lord to everyone like he does; he encourages new Christians, he witnesses to lost ones and he has a deep understanding of the Bible and its teaching, with a prophetic gift.

I came from a broken family and my first few years in Hong Kong were not easy; when I first met Elijah, I had barely any friends and was going through a personal crisis. He offered his friendship unconditionally and never once made any attempts to force himself upon me, beyond the friendship, though he made it clear that he had an interest in starting a relationship, he waited patiently till I was ready.

His love for others has manifested many times; he brought to the Lord many of our present and past friends and acts as a spiritual guide to anyone in need of prayer and help. He also became the sponsor for a

young couple from Pakistan who had surrendered their passport to the HK Immigration for religious persecution reasons; he located accommodation for them and put together a group of sponsors to finance the couple's monthly expenses. He was further able to ensure an amount which will help the couple re-settle in another country in the future.

He never differentiates, judges or has prejudice for any person and this is the greatest teaching a Christian can put into practice. He hates unrighteousness and sin. He supports me in everything I do, gives me great encouragement and always stands by my side. He is a fair father to the children, he loves them deeply and only disciplines them when they become very naughty, and teaches them to be good Christians.

During the past years, we have had some bad experiences with local churches weak in the True Doctrine and also with false Christians. Some tried to hurt us badly, even trying to interfere in our personal lives. Elijah always stands firm in his faith and love for his family. I have been most disturbed by some of these people's comments towards my husband but all they have achieved is to strengthen our relationship and love for each other and the Lord. Shame on these "so-called professing Christians" full of hate for their neighbours, full of prejudice, unable to see beyond a person's looks, quick to judge and gossip.

He saw me through a difficult time when my mother was diagnosed with cancer and later recovered but developed depression. He invited her to live with us in Hong Kong, cared greatly for her, encouraged her daily with his faith. She was Saved by The Lord before her illness through Christ's Teachings delivered by Elijah. He was also of tremendous support when she finally went to Heaven last year.

I daily thank God for this wonderful husband He has given me and I am trying to learn from Elijah to be less selfish and more dedicated in loving others in the same way he does. I look at my husband and I see the love of Jesus in his eyes.
